Academic Session 2024-25 Undergraduate Course (UG) Admissions (B.A./B.Sc./B.Com. I)

Admissions to the undergraduate programs at Shyama Prasad Mukherjee Government Degree College (A Constituent Post Graduate College of the University of Allahabad) for the academic session 2024-25 will be based on the scores obtained in the CUET (UG-2024). Additionally, candidates who did not appear in the CUET-UG 2024 (**NON-CUET** candidates) or those who appeared but did not register for the University of Allahabad can also apply for admission to the undergraduate courses. Admission of **NON-CUET** candidates in UG Program is according to the availability of seats.

CUET candidates may seek admission in the subjects for which they passed the CUET-exam as well as in non-subjects as per their eligibility. **CUET** candidates will be given preference in admission over **NON-CUET** candidates. Admission of **NON-CUET** candidates to the UG programs will be based on the merit list prepared by the college on the basis of marks obtained in qualifying exam.

- Prospective candidates interested in seeking admission must carefully review the contents of the Admissions Procedure, along with any notifications, updates, and information provided on the College Website (www.spm mau.ac.in).
- College follows the guidelines of University of Allahabad for admission in undergraduate programs
- Admission to all UG Programs of the College for the session 2024-2025 will be done online through the College Website (www.spm mau.ac.in) only.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

- The eligibility criteria for admission in different UG Courses are mentioned in the list **ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR UNDERGRADUATE COURSES (click here to view pdf)**.
- The applicants with Science Stream or having Geography as one of the subjects at 10+2/Intermediate level will be eligible for the B.A. Programme with subject combination having Geography.

GENERAL INFORMATION FOR UG ADMISSION 2024

1. The candidates desirous for seeking admission to various UG programmes must have appeared in CUET-UG-2024.
2. The candidates who have not appeared in CUET-UG-2024 may also be eligible for admission in B.A./B.Sc. /B.Com. Programs in College. Such candidates must register on the admission portal of the college website (www.spm mau.ac.in). However, admission in the NON-CUET category is subject to the availability of seats. (**click here to view instructions for registration**)
3. A CUET-UG-2024 candidate registered in University of Allahabad is eligible for admission in UG Programs in the College.

4. CUET-2024 aspirants who are not registered themselves in University of Allahabad must register on the admission portal of the college website (www.spm.au.ac.in).
5. CUET-2024 aspirants may register themselves for the **domain subject papers** for which they passed the CUET-exam as well as for other subjects as per their eligibility.
6. Before registering for any UG Course, candidates must familiarize themselves with the Ordinances, Rules, and Regulations of the University of Allahabad available on the university website.
7. **Reservation policy of the Government of India for admissions in the Central Universities will be strictly followed.**
8. As per the eligibility criteria of the university, NTA normalized score of relevant subjects/test will only be considered.
9. The merit for each course shall be prepared by considering the NTA normalized score of all sections as per the eligibility criteria laid down by the University of Allahabad for the said course.
10. The eligibility criteria for BA and B Sc courses are only for admission purposes, the subject combinations will be allotted on the basis of merit prepared in accordance with NTA normalized score and the availability of seats.
11. Ragging in the University of Allahabad and its Constituents Colleges is strictly prohibited as per orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India. The Orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court have been communicated by the UGC letter no. F1-1/2006 (CPP-II) dated March 4, 2008. If any incident of ragging is reported it will invite stringent penal action according to law and as per the directives of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India.
12. Disputes related to admissions shall be under the jurisdiction of the Hon'ble Allahabad High Court of Judicature at Prayagraj only.
13. At the time of admission, the candidate must have passed the 10+2/ Intermediate/ Equivalent examination. The candidates who are still awaiting their result due to any reason such as compartment etc. shall not be eligible for admission in UG courses.
14. The candidate claiming admission under reserved category must have an Updated Certificate (appropriate to get admission to Central Educational Institutions, under the Government of India) issued from the competent authority.
15. Applicant should submit ABC (Academic Bank of Credits) ID at the time of registration. The ABC ID can be generated at **www.abc.gov.in**
16. Kindly visit the college website (www.spm.au.ac.in) regularly for updates regarding cut off merit, date of admission and physical verification.
17. All admissions are provisional and subject to the physical verification of the original documents by the physical verification/admission committee of the college. Candidate's presence is must at the time of physical verification.

RESERVATION AND SPECIAL CONSIDERATION/QUOTA (as per rules and regulations of University of Allahabad)

Reservation policy of the Government of India for admissions in the Central Universities will be strictly followed.

In accordance with provision of Section 9 of the University of Allahabad Act, 2005 (Act No. 26 of 2005) seats shall be reserved for Scheduled Caste (SC), Scheduled Tribe (ST) and Other Backward Classes (OBC) category candidates in all subjects/course for which the Admission Test has been held, as given here under:

- (i) 15% of the total seats in each subject/course shall be reserved for candidates belonging to Scheduled Caste (SC) category;
- (ii) 7.5% of the total seats in each subject/course shall be reserved for candidates belonging to Scheduled Tribe (ST) category; and
- (iii) 27% of the total seats in each subject/course shall be reserved for candidates belonging to the Other Backward Caste (OBC) category.
- (iv) In case the seats reserved for Scheduled Tribe (ST) category candidates remain vacant on account of non-availability of candidates the same shall be filled by the candidates of Scheduled Caste (SC) candidates.
- (v) 10% of the total seats shall be reserved for candidate belonging to EWS category. Reservation to EWS candidates shall be given by the University as per Govt. of India guidelines, the regulation/norms issued by the UGC and subject to any decision of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India or Hon'ble High Court of Allahabad, if any.

Note: These rules are indicative and UGC Regulation on Reservation and directives of Ministry of Education as on the date of declaration of Results shall be followed.

Kashmiri Migrants:

Weightage as per Government of India guidelines shall be given to Kashmiri Migrants. In order to avail this weightage, the candidates shall have to present a certificate to this effect from an officer of the Ministry of Education not below the rank of Joint Secretary or equivalent.

Sports Quota:

Under Sports-Quota, at the graduate level only those candidates can be considered for admission who are eligible to participate in Inter-University Tournaments as per Association of Indian Universities (AIU), New Delhi rules and have participated at State and National Championships organized under School Games Federation of India and Junior Level (under 19 years of age) District, Region, State and National Championships organized by various District/State Associations and Federations. The candidates will be selected in order of merit subject to availability of seats.

1. The Sports Board, University of Allahabad* reserves the right to conduct the field trials and verification of documents of any candidate to determine genuineness of the documents.
2. The candidate shall be required to produce all the original game / sports certificate in support of his/her claim at the time of admission / interview. The University reserves the right to verify the documents (games / sports certificates etc.) and if found fake, suitable action shall be taken against the candidate.
3. **2% of the total seats in each subject/ course shall be allotted under Sports Quota.**
4. Admission under separate quota will strictly be on the basis of merit list provided by the advisory committee, Sports Board.

*** In the college, the Sports Admission Committee, SPM Govt Degree college will work.**

Person with Disability (Divyang) (Pw D):

1. As per section 32(1) of the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016, all Government institutions of higher education and other higher education institutions receiving aid from the Government shall reserve not less than five (05) per cent seats for person with benchmark disabilities.

Therefore 5% of total seats for this course will be available for person with disability who can pursue this course without any difficulty.

2. A candidate who has a certified disability of not less than 40 % in any limb or in orthopaedic structure which, in the opinion of the Medical Board (constituted by the University of Allahabad), amounts to an overall physical handicap of not more than 70% or is a certified Visually impaired or a Hearing impaired, may be admitted to the concerned course / subject, irrespective of his position in the order of merit of the total aggregate score, on the recommendation of the Medical Board.
3. Seats under this quota shall be filled in order of preference given below. One percent each shall be reserved for person with benchmark disability under clause (a), (b) and (c), and one percent with benchmark disability under clauses (d) and (e) namely.
 - a. Blindness and low vision.
 - b. Deaf and hard of hearing.
 - c. Locomotor disability including cerebral palsy, leprosy cured dwarfism, acid attack victims and muscular dystrophy.
 - d. Autism, intellectual disability, specific learning disability and mental illness.
 - e. Multiple disabilities from amongst person from clauses (a) to (d).
4. The privilege shall not be given except claimed by the candidate at the time of application. At the time of admission, the candidate shall be required to produce a certificate issued by the Chief Medical Officer of the appropriate District or by the Viklang Kendra, Allahabad, which testifies to his disability and bears an attested photograph indicating his / her disability clearly.
5. All candidates entitled to be admitted under the above quota to a course shall be adjusted against their respective social category.

Teacher/Employee Ward Quota:

After the completion of admission on the sanctioned seats in each course of study, the wife, husband, sons and daughters of regularly appointed serving and retired teachers / employee of the University, the University Institutes, the constituents Colleges and constituents Institutes, who produce relevant certificate duly signed by the Registrar in case of University, the Director in case of University Institutes, the Principal in the case of constituent Colleges and the Director in case of constituent Institutes shall be admitted, on the basis of their relative scores against 5% supernumerary seats (with a minimum of one seat) in each course of study, only in the unit/sub-unit in which such Teachers/Employees are serving or where from they have superannuated. Provided that if in case seats remain vacant in a course in the unit/subunit, these will be filled by the wards of the employees of other units/subunits and wards of contractual and daily wage employees of the University, University Institutes, the Centers thereof and the independent Centers.

Note-Teacher/Employee Ward benefit will be granted only when the candidate has made such a claim in the Application Form and presents the required documents and certificates at the time of admission. The order of merit for admission shall be determined on the basis of computed marks of the candidate.

- (i) Admission will be done on the basis of merit list announced by Director on computed marks.
- (ii) Computed Marks = Candidate's Test Score + Weightage/Premium (if any) – Deductions (if any)
- (iii) If two or more candidates obtain the same computed total marks, their relative merit for the purpose of admission and/or allotment of subjects (s) shall be determined on the following basis:
 - a. The marks obtained by the candidate in the Intermediate or equivalent examination;
 - b. In case the marks obtained by the two candidates in the Intermediate or equivalent examinations are equal then the marks obtained by the two candidates in the High School or equivalent examination;
 - c. In case the marks obtained by the two candidates in the High School or equivalent examination are also equal, then by the draw of lots.

Registration For UG Programs

Who can register?

1. The students who appeared in CUET but are not registered with University of Allahabad for the courses/programs.
2. The students who appeared in CUET may register for any course as per their eligibility irrespective of the domain subject papers in which they appeared.
3. The candidates who have not appeared in CUET-UG-2024 i.e. NON-CUET candidates may register for any course/program as per their eligibility.

Important Instructions for registration

- Candidates must be cautious while filling out Registration Form.
- Before Registration, the applicant should ensure that they fulfil the eligibility criteria.
- Applicants can register for either single program or multiple programs of their choice. For each program they will register separately with registration fee.
- The applicant must have the following documents: -
 - a. CUET-UG (2024) Admit Card (only for CUET aspirants)
 - b. Class 10, 10+2 marksheet cum Certificate/ Marksheet & Certificate.
 - c. Photo and signature of the candidate in .jpg/.jpeg format
 - d. Recent Caste Certificate in Central Government format for EWS/OBC-NCL/SC/ST bearing Certificate numbers and Certificate issuance date.
 - e. ABC (Academic Bank of Credits) ID. The ABC ID can be generated at www.abc.gov.in
- The applicant can select course on the Registration portal.
- The basic details of the applicant, such as Name, Father's Name, Mother's Name and Date of Birth must match with the 10th /High-School certificate-cum-marksheet at the time of registration at the College Portal.
- Registration fee (non-refundable) for respective social categories is as under:

Category	Fee
UR/OBC-NCL /EWS	Rs 300
SC/ST/PwD	Rs 150

- Registration will be complete only after successful remittance of the registration fee.
- Applicants, who have successfully registered and paid the registration fee either on the University of Allahabad or College registration portal will be considered for the admission in UG programs in the college.
